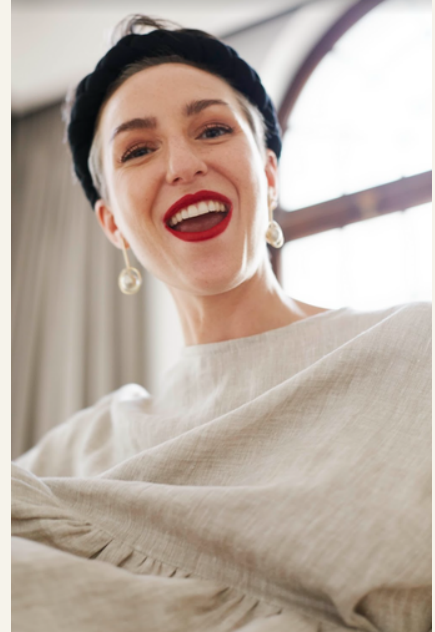


LOU'S EDIT

before we dive in, some tips...

- Packing is made easy when sticking to a tonal colour palette.
- On game drives & walking Safaris, it is advised to wear colours that "blend in" with the environment. Avoid very bright colours including white.
- If you're travelling to an area with Tsetse flies, avoid wearing very dark colours.
- White, however, is lovely to wear at camp as it is cool and repels insects.

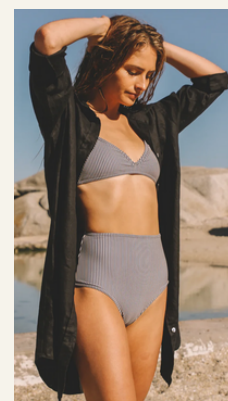

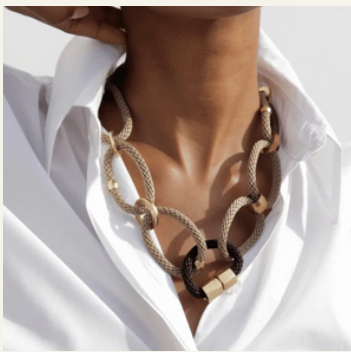
